Section 17923 Business and Professions Code

17923 (a) Any person who is a general partner in a partnership that is or has been regularly transacting business under a fictitious business name **may**, upon withdrawing as a general partner, file a statement of withdrawal from the partnership operating under a fictitious business name. The statement shall be executed by the person filing the statement in the same manner as a fictitious business name statement and **shall** be filed with the county clerk of the county where the partnership filed its fictitious business name statement.

(b)The statement **shall** include:

- (1) The fictitious business name of the partnership.
- (2) The date on which the fictitious business name statement for the partnership was filed, the file number, and the county where filed.
- (3) The street address of its principal place of business in this state or, if it has no place of business in this state, the street address of its principal place of business outside this state, if any.
- (4) The full names and residence addresses of the person or persons withdrawing as a partner(s).

(c) The statement of withdrawal from the partnership operating under a fictitious business name shall be published in the same manner as the fictitious business name statement and an affidavit showing the publication of the statement **shall** be filed with the county clerk after the completion of the publication.

(d) The withdrawal of a general partner does not cause a fictitious business name statement to expire if the withdrawing partner files a statement of withdrawal meeting the requirements of this section.

Notice to Person(s) –Section 17924 Business and Professions Code

(1) Your Statement of Withdrawal from the Partnership Operating under a Fictitious Business Name must be published in a newspaper once a week for four successive weeks and an affidavit of publication filed with the county clerk when publication has been accomplished. The statement should be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the county where the principal place of business is located. The statement should be published in such county in a newspaper that circulates in the area where the business is conducted. (Business and Professions Code Section 17917).

(2) Any person who executes, files or publishes any statement, knowing that such statement is false, in whole or in part, is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1000), (Business and Professions Code Section 17930).
