

JUDICIAL CAMPAIGN ETHICS

ONLINE COURSE

The Supreme Court of California in 2013 added a requirement to the Code of Judicial Ethics that every candidate for judicial office “complete a judicial campaign ethics course approved by the Supreme Court no earlier than one year before or no later than 60 days after either the filing of a declaration of intention by the candidate, the formation of a campaign committee, or the receipt of any campaign contribution, whichever is earliest.” Canon 5B(3)

This 90-minute online course, approved by the Supreme Court and produced by CJER and the collaborative effort of the California Judges Association, the Supreme Court Advisory Committee on the Code of Judicial Ethics, and the California State Bar, satisfies that requirement.
