**PERMANENT VOTE BY MAIL VOTER INFORMATION**

California law allows any registered voter to become a Permanent Vote By Mail Voter. If you would like to automatically receive a Vote By Mail ballot for future elections, complete the application below and return it to the Ventura County Elections Division, 800 South Victoria Avenue, Ventura, CA 93009-1200.

If you choose to become a Permanent Vote By Mail Voter:

- An official Vote By Mail ballot will automatically be mailed to you approximately 4 weeks prior to each election in which you are qualified to vote.
- There will be no need to mail in any other form.
- If you fail to vote by mail in four consecutive statewide general elections, your name will be deleted from the list of Permanent Vote By Mail voters and you will need to reapply. (California Elections Code Section 3206)
