

How To Vote Statewide Direct Primary Election Tuesday, June 5, 2018

1. Mark your ballot

- Follow the directions on the ballot.
- Make sure the ballot is marked correctly as shown below:



2. Seal your ballot

- Check that you have the Return Envelope with your name on it.
- Put your ballot into the envelope.
- Seal the envelope.

3. Sign the envelope

- Date & sign your name on the back of the envelope in black or blue ink.
- Print your name and voter registration address.

You have 3 ways to return your Vote By Mail ballot



Vote By Mail

Mail your ballot so that it is postmarked by Election Day, June 5, 2018

Within the U.S we recommend 2 first class stamps.



Drop Box

You can drop off your ballot at a secure drop boxes located around the county-no postage required. (See back for Information.)



Polling Place

Drop off your ballot on Election Day at any polling place in Ventura County between 7 am to 8 pm. (See back for information.)

Drop Boxes are only available during regular business hours. The Gov't Center drop box is available 24 hours.

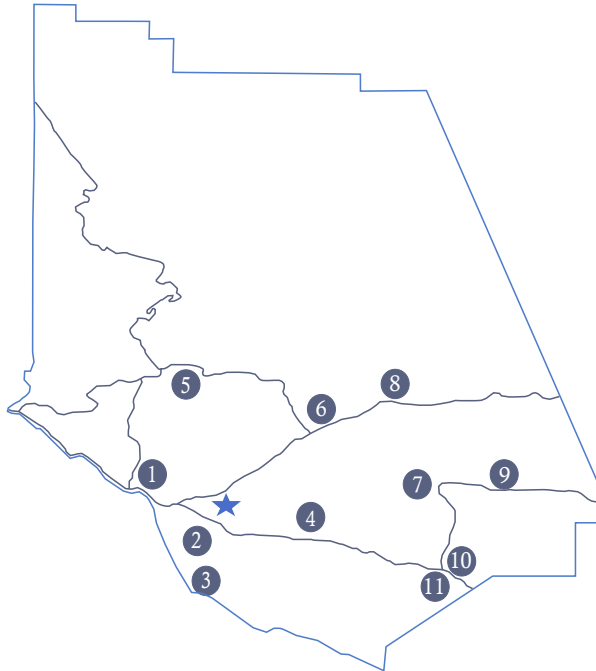
