MILITARY AND OVERSEAS VOTING

Members of the Uniformed Services, members of the U.S. Merchant Marine, eligible family members, and U.S. citizens residing outside the United States or the District of Columbia are eligible to register to vote and request an absentee ballot (Vote By Mail) by submitting a Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) to the local elections official.

Vote By Mail Ballot Return by Fax or In Person	November 3, 2020 8 PM PST
Vote By Mail Ballot Return by Mail	Postmarked on or before November 3, 2020 and received no later than November 20, 2020 (17 days after Election Day).
