

ORDINANCE NO. 4546

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1287 OF ARTICLE 6,  
CHAPTER 2, DIVISION 1 OF THE VENTURA COUNTY  
ORDINANCE CODE, REGARDING LOCAL CAMPAIGN FINANCE  
REFORM TO ADD A LOCAL FILING REQUIREMENT FOR  
COUNTY CANDIDATES REQUIRED TO FILE FPPC FORM 460,  
IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES, WITH SPECIFIC LIMITATIONS**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Ventura ordains as follows:

Section 1. Enactment of Section 1287, Subdivision (e). The Ventura County Campaign Finance Reform Ordinance, adopted as Ordinance No. 4506 and amended by Ordinance No. 4510, is hereby further amended to add the following language as a new subdivision (e) to current Section 1287 (Disclosure of Contributions) thereof, as follow:

(e) In the year before a March direct primary, county candidates who are required to file FPPC Form 460 (Recipient Committee Campaign Statement) shall file a special FPPC Form 460 with the Clerk. This special FPPC Form 460 shall cover the period between the end of the preceding FPPC Form 460 reporting period and October 30 (of the year before the March direct primary) and shall contain the information required by FPPC Form 460. The special FPPC Form 460 shall be filed with the Clerk no later than November 30 of the same year. This subdivision shall not apply if the Fair Political Practices Commission or other state agency requires county candidates to file FPPC Form 460 or a similar Recipient Committee Campaign Statement during October or November of the year preceding a March direct primary.

Section 2. No Other Amendments. Except as amended hereby, the provisions of the Ventura County Campaign Finance Reform Ordinance, as adopted by Ordinance No. 4506 and amended by Ordinance No. 4510, shall remain fully in force and effect.
