MILITARY AND OVERSEAS VOTING

Members of the Uniformed Services, members of the U.S. Merchant Marine, eligible family members, and U.S. citizens residing outside the United States or the District of Columbia are eligible to register to vote and request an absentee ballot (Vote By Mail) by submitting a Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) to the local elections official.

Registration	August 30, 2021
Vote By Mail Ballot Request	September 7, 2021
Vote By Mail Ballot Return by Fax or In Person	September 14, 2021 8 PM PST
Vote By Mail Ballot Return by Mail	Postmarked on or before September 14, 2021 and received no later than September 21, 2021 (7 days after Election Day).
